Good News Garage – LSS

What: Good News Garage – LSS (Lutheran Social Services) creates economic opportunity by providing affordable and reliable transportation options to people in need. Good News Garage (GNG) accepts donated cars, trucks, and vans, repairs them and then offers them to low-income individuals. GNG fundraises and sells vehicles not used in the program to cover the cost of repairing those that go to low-income individuals.

When: Ascension supports Vermont GNG with an annual contribution in the Ascension operating budget.

Who: Bill Valliere and Sam Swanson are contacts for the Vermont GNG.

How: Since its inception in 1998, Ascension has provided a major contribution of time and talent, helping GNG get started and then supporting the GNG mission with volunteer assistance. The GNG administrative offices were housed at Ascension when it was started. Pastor Neu and Bill Valliere were partners with Hal Colston in designing the GNG program and getting it started. Since then many members have contributed individual car donations, cash donations, time at the garage doing all kinds of different tasks, participating in the community advisory committee, and serving on the LSSNE GNG Board of Directors.

Vermont GNG is included in Ascension's operating budget with a cash contribution.

The GNG depends on a steady stream of car donations. All members of our congregation can contribute by encouraging friends, family, and acquaintances to consider giving their cars to the GNG as a tax-deductable charitable contribution. Cash contributions are needed and welcome.
